A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS (DPWH) TO REPAINT ALL PEDESTRIAN LANES IN THE CITY ESPECIALLY THOSE NEAR AND IN FRONT OF SCHOOLS

WHEREAS, pedestrian lanes are guides where people can cross the street safely without hindering the flow of traffic;

WHEREAS, pedestrian lanes are most useful when the elderly, the infirmed and school children use it to cross the street and pedestrian lanes are the legal sections of the street where people can cross the street without fear of being accosted by police officers for committing jaywalking;

WHEREAS, pedestrian lanes which are usually painted regularly with bright yellow color are presently in need of fresh coat of paint, especially those near and/or in front of school;

WHEREAS, the repainting is necessary since most school children and students use pedestrian lanes and without visible painted marks on these pedestrian lanes, students are prone to just cross the street;

WHEREAS, for reasons of safety and practicality, these pedestrian lanes near and/or in front of schools need to be repainted;

WHEREAS, the DPWH is urge to coordinate with the Davao City Traffic Management Center (TMC) for the monitoring of all pedestrian lanes in Davao City;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) be requested to repaint all pedestrian lanes especially those near and/or in front of schools;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of this resolution be furnished the DPWH for their information and guidance.
