**A RESOLUTION BRINGING THE ISSUES AND CONCERNS RAISED DURING THE TRANSPORT SUMMIT TO CORRESPONDING AGENCIES AND OFFICE OF THE GOVERNMENT FOR APPROPRIATE ACTION**

- WHEREAS,** last September 18, 2008, the City Council's Committee on Energy, Transportation and Communication in coordination with TRANSMISSION and the Integrated District Tricycle Federation successfully conducted a Transport Summit at the Sangguniang Panlungsod;
- WHEREAS,** the theme of the Summit was: "Driver ug Katawhan: Ipadayon ang Pakigbisug alang sa Pagtanggap sa EVAT ug Aron I-roll back ang Presyo sa Lana;"
- WHEREAS,** the Transport Summit which was attended by the transport sector of the City and most associations of public utility jeepneys was conducted to generate ideas, explore opportunities and plans, and identify expected outputs from the participants of the transport sector;
- WHEREAS,** the primary objectives of the Transport Summit were the scrapping of VAT on oil; multicab phase-out; issues on existence of All Aboard Transport franchise; opening of franchise for tricycle; the LTO's system of adjudication relative to the apprehension of violators; and proposed transport strike as the highest form of transport protest;
- WHEREAS,** as synthesis, the participants to the Transport Summit collectively indicated important issues and concerns;
- WHEREAS,** one issue was to support the Proposed Bill in Congress scrapping the 12% EVAT on oil and a black Friday protest was conducted last September 26, 2008 from 9 AM to 10PM at Jones Circle to show support for these bills;
- WHEREAS,** another issue is "No to Multi-Cab Phase out" – the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB) should look into the performance of the unit and not the year model as basis for the renewal of multicab franchise and a picket at LTFRB will be held on October 8, 2008 from 9 to 11 AM and a signature campaign of the affected operators and drivers shall be conducted in support of this issue;
- WHEREAS,** still another issue is to recommend the cancellation of All Aboard Transport franchises and converting the units into a rent-a-car business because of the violations and conditions committed by the All Aboard Transport Group, this issue will be included in their picket on October 8, 2008;
- WHEREAS,** the last issue is to schedule a possible dialogue with the City Mayor Rodrigo relative to the opening of franchises for "colorum" tricycle and the possibility of creating an independent body for the adjudication of violators apprehended by the Land Transportation Office, Traffic Management Committee and the Traffic Management Center;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**, that a resolution be passed by this Body bringing the issues and concerns raised during the transport summit to corresponding agencies and office of the government for appropriate action;

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that copies of this resolution be furnished TRANSMISSION, the Integrated District Tricycle Federation, the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB), the Land Transportation Office (LTO), All Aboard Transport, the Traffic Management Center and the Office of the City Mayor for their information and appropriate action.
